Denying Human Depravity (The Negative Terminal)

“I’m a good person!”

This person usually compares his/her life with those of others

“At least I didn’t _____ like he/she did!”

Denying The Power of The Gospel (The Positive Terminal)

“You don’t know the things I’ve done!”

“I have done too many things wrong for God to still care about me!”

“I’ve already crossed too many lines. It just doesn’t matter anymore!”

Denying Both The Negative And Positive Terminals

Agnostics: Don’t know whether there is a God or not

Secularists: Fully invested in the world and its philosophies

“This life is all that there is!”

The Gospel In Three Verses

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.
